This is based off of the drama game Who's missing? But since you probably only have a few people at home, that would be over pretty quickly! So I wracked my brain and came up with What's missing?!

HOW IT WORKS

So the idea is you pick any room in your house and get player 1 to look at the whole room for 60 seconds, memorising as much of it as they can, then they leave the room and player 2 picks an object and hides it away, then player 1 come back into the room and tries to guess what was taken away. Player 2 can make the object be as obvious or subtle as you like, changing the difficulty level. This game can go on for ages if you want it to!

Rules

- 1. Player 1 is only allowed 1 3 guesses (depending on difficulty)
- 2. If they get it right, it's their turn
- 3. if they get it wrong Player 2 has another go
