**Difficulty level: medium**

**Fun level: WOOOP!**

### CREATE YOUR OWN SCRIPT USING THE ALPHABET!

#### *Instructions:*

1. Write **the alphabet** down the left hand side of a piece of paper, leaving a line between each letter to give you plenty of space.
2. Starting with **A** write your first line of dialogue... but here's the tricky bit: the sentence has to begin with the letter '**A**! Something like 'All aboard the fun train!' or 'Apparently there are jelly beans on the moon.'
3. Using a different colour pen, write the next line of dialogue next to the letter **B**. This line must start with **B** and should be a response to the first line of dialogue.
4. Make a note to show which colours refer to which character.

For example:

Red = Charlie

Blue = Lola

A - **A**ctually the last biscuit is mine!

B - **B**ut you've had more than me

C - **C**an't you see I'm starving?!

D - **D**on't pull that trick... how can you be starving when you've had so many?!

E - **E**xcuse me, may I remind you, you had ALL the icecream and the doughnuts!

F - **F**orgot about that...

*And so on...*

See if you can get all the way to Z. If you do you'll have your very own 26 line script! Try reading the script out loud and see if you can change your voice for the different characters. Or if a sibling or parent is around, see if they will play the other character.
